

# 2021 WHITETAILS OF WISCONSIN CONTESTS

Whitetails of Wisconsin will be sponsoring photo, antler, early-bird registration and Biggest Yearling contests at their Annual Banquet & Fundraiser on March 20, 2021 at The Three Bears Resort, Warrens, Wisconsin.

## Photo Contest

Winning photos will be used in future WOW magazines. They will not be returned unless you specify so. (If you are unable to attend, you may mail your photos in as long as they are mailed into the WOW Office **by March 10, 2021.**) The top three photos in each category will be recognized.

The categories are:

1. *Buck/Bull/Stag*
2. *Fawn/Calf*
3. *Humor & Action*
4. *Miscellaneous* – cervids & people, or cervids & other animals
5. *Winter Wonderland* – This category will require snow in the picture and anything else that is specifically related to cervids.

Photos are restricted to 4x6 or smaller. Amateurs only please.

Photos cannot be reentered into the contest if they have won in previous years.

*Be sure to put your name on the back of each photo and the category the photo is to be entered in!*

**Photos must be entered before 11:45 a.m. on March 20<sup>th</sup>. (Photo Voting closes at 3:15 p.m.)**

## Antler Competition

Antlers may be entered into competition on Saturday, March 20, 2021, from 8:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. only.

The categories will be as follows:

Antlers must be from bucks whose antlers were cut or shed in 2020 or 2021 and not entered in any previous WOW antler competition. There is a \$10 charge for each pair of antlers entered; no antlers may be left at the table until the entry fee has been received. The SCI scoring system will be employed; two official SCI scorers will be the ones doing the scoring. Antlers must have less than 10% non-typical to be classified in the typical category. A "Best in Show" award will be presented, based on membership votes; Best of Show voting closes at 2:45 p.m.

Lauren Kirchoff from ADM Animal Nutrition has again volunteered to donate the plaques for the winners of the antler competition. These plaques are pre-printed, so it is important to fill each category. Please bring in your sheds for competition!

**Antlers must be entered before 10:30 a.m. on March 20, 2021.**

# **2021 Biggest Yearling Contest**

## **Whitetails of Wisconsin & Wisconsin Cervid Farmers Foundation Biggest Yearling Contest**

Whitetails of Wisconsin (WOW) and its foundation, the Wisconsin Cervid Farmers Foundation (WCFF), will be sponsoring our 7<sup>th</sup> Annual “Biggest Yearling Buck Contest.”

The contest will consist of two categories; one for the largest non-typical yearling and one for the largest typical yearling. The way to participate is to win or purchase either a straw of semen or a live animal at the Whitetails of Wisconsin 2021 annual meeting. (Adult bucks are not included.) The buck fawns that are born in 2022 out of registered 2021 breeding declarations will stay in the competition until their yearling racks are scored at the 2023 WOW Banquet.

Donated straws of semen or live animals can be purchased on the silent or live auction or won at various games and raffles held at the 2021 WOW meeting. Donors can choose to have their donation placed in the live auction or silent auction to be purchased or placed in a game or raffle to be won. This will be the donor’s preference.

\$2000 will be awarded to the winner in each category. The winners of each category will also receive a free full-page ad and an article featuring their farms in the Whitetails of Wisconsin newsletter.

The donors that helped produce the largest yearlings in each category will receive a free full-page ad and an article featuring their farms in the Whitetails of Wisconsin newsletter. The donors will also receive a lifetime membership to Whitetails of Wisconsin or a \$500 cash prize. If the winning buck’s sire of donated semen or buck fawn is not currently DNA’d, donor will be required to supply DNA sample prior to the DNA test and prior to receiving their cash reward or the cost will be retained from said cash reward.

DNA samples will be collected from the top three contest winners of both typicals and non-typical to avoid any delays in confirming and announcing the true winner if, for any reason, a DNA sampling does not match up as thought.

### **Rules for the contest:**

1. Semen obtained at 2021 WOW Auction:
  - a. The semen must be used within the Fall 2021 breeding.
  - b. A maximum of 3 does can be bred per straw of semen used. **(SUGGESTION: If your does are not already DNA’d, pull their hair samples at time of breeding.)**
2. Live Animals obtained at 2021 WOW Auction:
  - a. Live animal donors must submit a completed Animal Declaration form with exact breeding at time of entering donation into the 2021 WOW Auction.
  - b. At time of purchase or winning said live animal, it is automatically entered into the appropriate Biggest Yearling Contest year: (e.g. if the live animal is a Bred doe-she will be entered into the 2020 BYC; Open Doe-entered into the 2021 BYC; 2020 Buck Fawn-entered into the 2019 BYC; and 2020 Doe Fawn-entered into the 2021 BYC.)
3. All Does, Dams and Breeder bucks need to be declared by completing the Animal Declaration form and providing it to the WOW/WCFF Office with each doe’s official tag number and any secondary tag number or DNA number and submit it prior to or at the 2022 Annual WOW Banquet.
4. Any “farm credit” or “choice straw” purchases must include copy of receipt or email showing the WOW Office the official ID, number of semen chosen or live animal used and submitted with their Animal Declaration.
5. Doe and Dam DNA numbers need to be registered with the WOW/WCFF Office by **August 1, 2022 (or August 1, 2021 for 2020 buck fawn)**.
6. Each winning yearling buck will need the buck’s antlers DNA certified in order to be eligible for the contest payout. The cost to DNA certify the antlers will be absorbed by WOW.
7. No limit on the amount of entries per farm/ranch.
8. Buyers of semen or animal who do not AI can partner with someone else who does AI or can AI the doe at another farm.
9. The contest is not limited to Wisconsin buyers and is open to everyone.
10. Scoring of any buck fawns born in 2021 will have their antlers scored during the 2023 WOW Banquet by an official SCI scoring panel.
11. All semen donated to WOW or WCFF cannot be resold.
